

MASTER OF ART IN TEACHING (MAT)*

*WITH ONE-YEAR PRACTICUM

The **Master of Arts in Teaching** is a 36-credit Master's program that prepares graduates to earn an initial teaching license in Massachusetts while also providing the Master's level coursework required for a professional teaching license. This is the optimal program for students who have an active studio practice and want to teach in diverse PK-12 educational contexts. Students usually complete the full-time 36-credit MAT program in five semesters. After three years of teaching on the initial license, graduates may apply for a Massachusetts professional teaching license without further coursework.
